CHECK LIST

Please Tick:

Two months before moving

- Make your home feel specious by placing all excess furniture and non essential items into storage; Not in your garage.
- Take a copy of all our storage tips to help you plan your move more effectively.
- Talk to Container Parks about van hire or organising a removal firm.
- Arrange your packing and storage supplies
- Start sorting and clearing your loft and garage. Place all important documents in archive boxes and label clearly. If required, you can put some of these items into storage to make your moving day easier.

One month before moving

- Start packing items that are used infrequently.
- Register with your new doctor, dentist, school etc if you are moving out of the area.
- If you are moving to a new town, a local map can be handy.
- Ensure all your arrangements are in place.
- Maps of new location.

Two weeks before moving

- Contact all utility and service companies to arrange supply to your new home.
- Make sure you take readings of your gas and electricity on the day of leaving and forward the information to the appropriate service provider.
- Inform all relevant people and companies of your change of address.
- Organise your mail to be re-directed for at least three months.

One week before moving

- Confirm with your solicitor that your moving date has been confirmed.
- Make sure that all your packing is on schedule.
- Remind friends and family that you may need their help to move.

The day before

- All items that you will need on your moving day such as; Tape measure, extension leads, step ladder, keys, tools etc should be put to one side.
- If moving yourself, collect hire van at the best time.
- To assist with any heavy items ask our Park Manager about the availability of trolley or fork lift trucks etc.
- Move all packed boxes into a suitable room downstairs. This will help when loading your goods on moving day.

On moving day

- Make sure you carry with you: keys to your new home and existing home, directions and map if required, money, important documents, your 'essentials box', any items of great personal value, hygiene supplies and a fresh change of clothes.
- Place dustsheets on carpets when moving in and out to avoid any floor damage.
- Un-load your belongings and place them in a designated arrivals room.
- If you have used a removal company, do an inventory and damage check before signing any paperwork.
- If you have hired a van, clean out and return as arranged.
